FAMILY PLANNING

The OACAC Family Planning Program has provided the Ozarks with comprehensive family planning services as part of the Ozarks Area Community Action Corporation, since 1979.

Parenthood is one of the greatest responsibilities an individual can face. The decision to become a parent requires careful thought and planning.

We believe ALL individuals should be able to plan and prepare themselves for parenthood and that each child should be a wanted child.

The goal of OACAC Family Planning is to provide individuals with low cost quality reproductive health care and the supplies and information necessary to make personal choices in determining the number and spacing of their children.

All OACAC Family Planning services are completely confidential.

SERVICES

Physical exams and consultation visits are performed by licensed health professionals, including medical doctors and nurse practitioners. Our counselors are trained to provide sensitive, non-judgemental education and counseling regarding family planning options.

Clinic Services Include

- Routine gynecological exams, which may include pap smear, pelvic exam, breast exam, weight and blood pressure check, HIV test, cholesterol check, and hematocrit (test for anemia)
- Screening and treatment of vaginal infections, urinary tract infections (UTIs), and sexually transmitted diseases (STDs)
- Pregnancy testing, counseling and referral
- Education and counseling on birth control options
- Prescription and non-prescription birth control supplies

Birth Control

Prescription Methods

(Clinician visit and/or consultation required)

- Oral contraceptives (the pill)
- NuvaRing
- Depo-Provera (injection)
- IUD (Intrauterine Device)
(Hormonal and non-hormonal)
- Nexplanon (implant)

Non-Prescription Methods

- Emergency contraceptive pills (ECPs)
- Condoms and foam
- Abstinence
- Natural family planning

Fees for medical services and contraceptives are on a sliding scale based on income and family size. No one will be denied services due to inability to pay. Medicaid and some private insurances are accepted. No age or marital restrictions for services.
