- Acquire concepts and skills to build math and science knowledge.

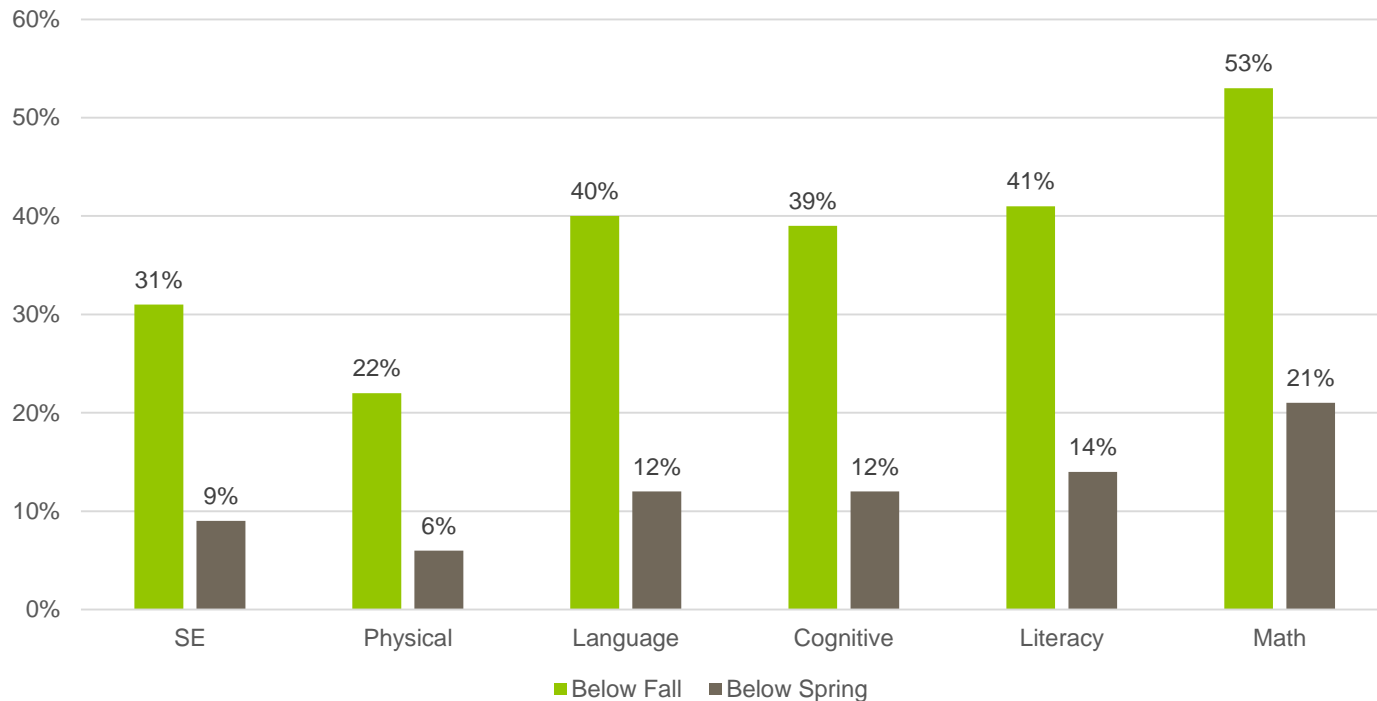
School Readiness Goals

- Develop and practice health and safety habits.

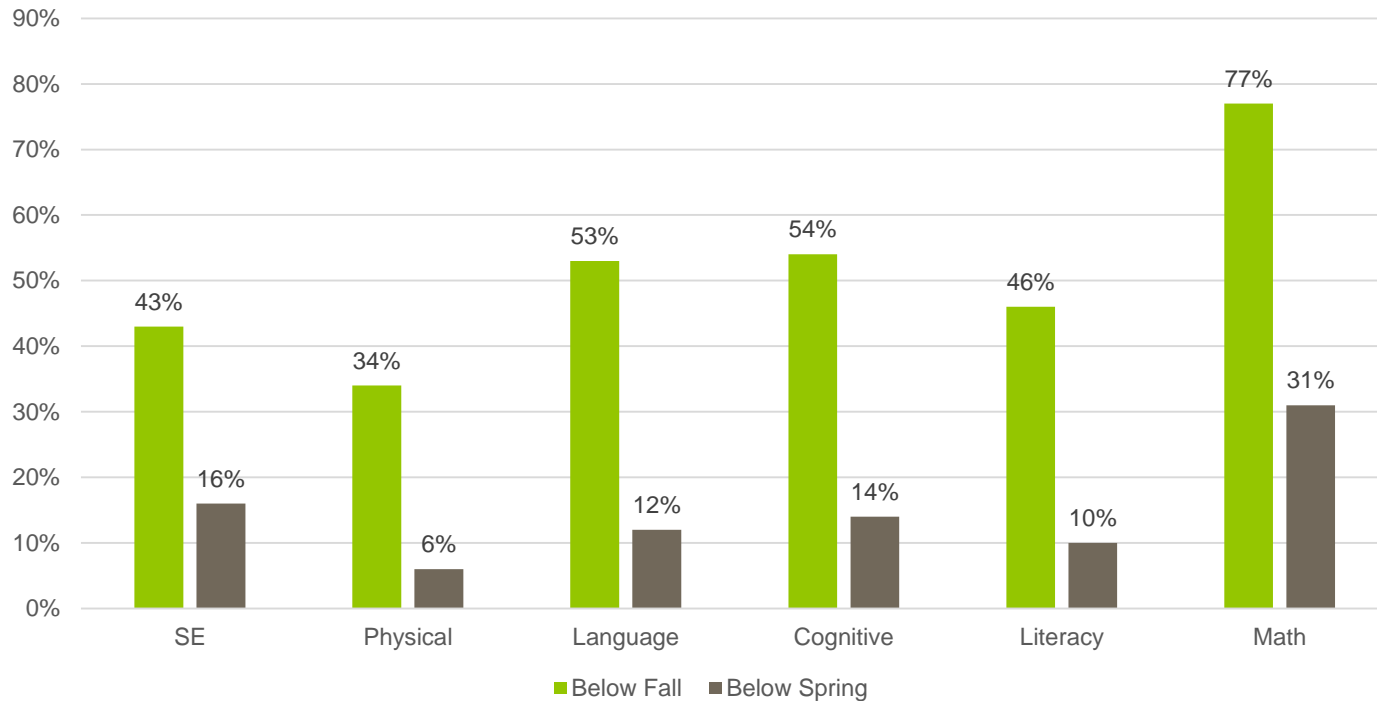
OACAC Head Start Demographics Spring 2018

 - Primary Language: 89% English 8% Spanish

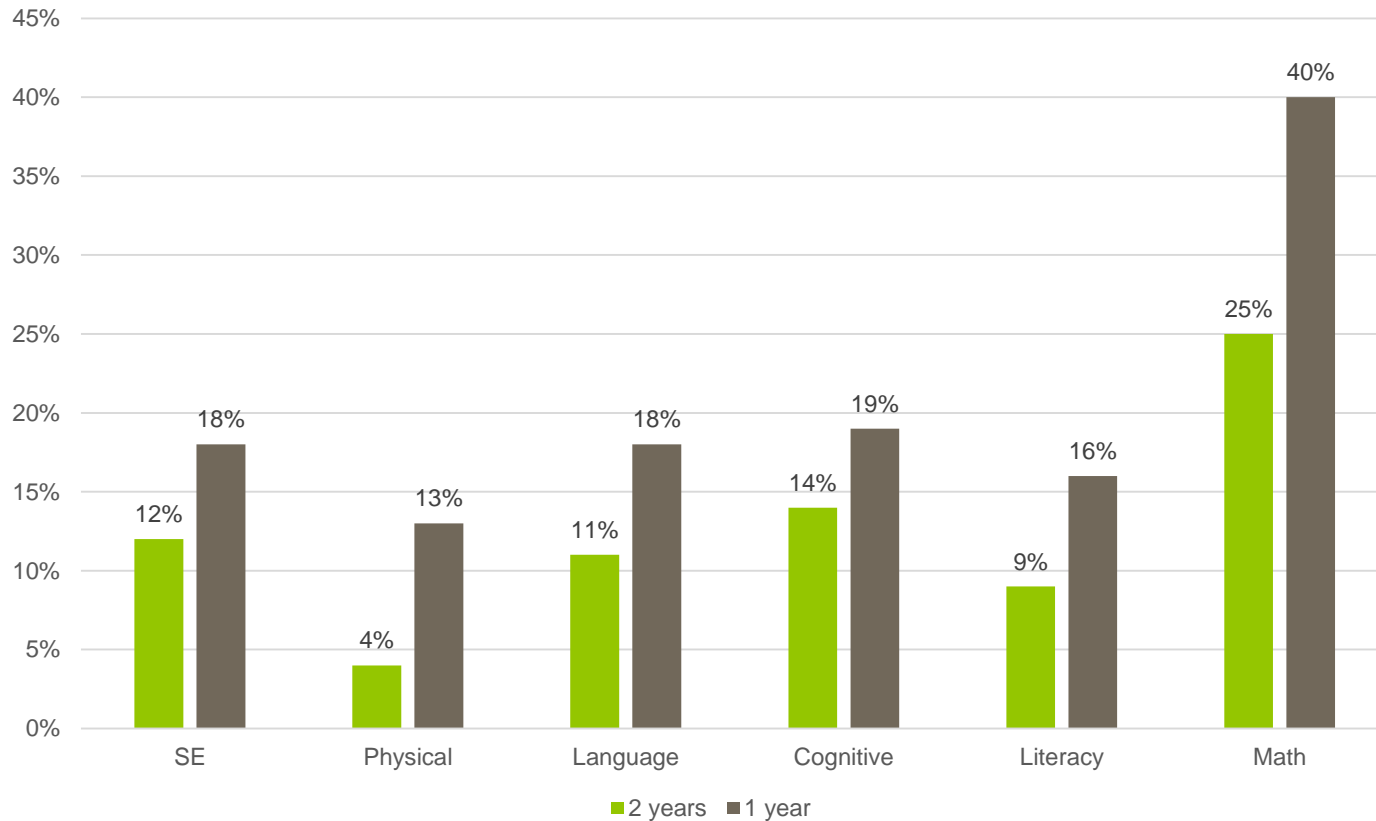
Program Comparison Fall to Spring: Program Widely Held Expectations (WHE)



Fall to Spring-4 YO Below WHE

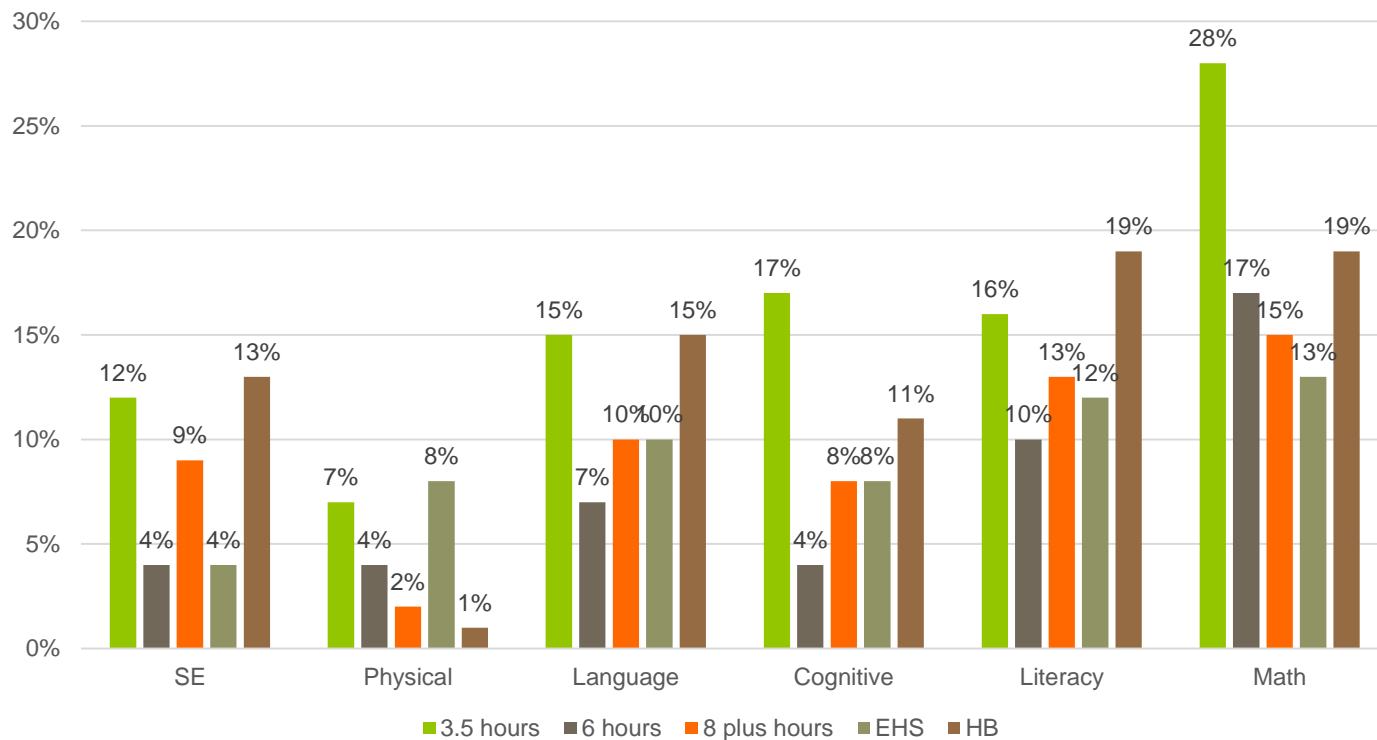


4 Year Olds Behind WHE-2 years in program vs. 1 year

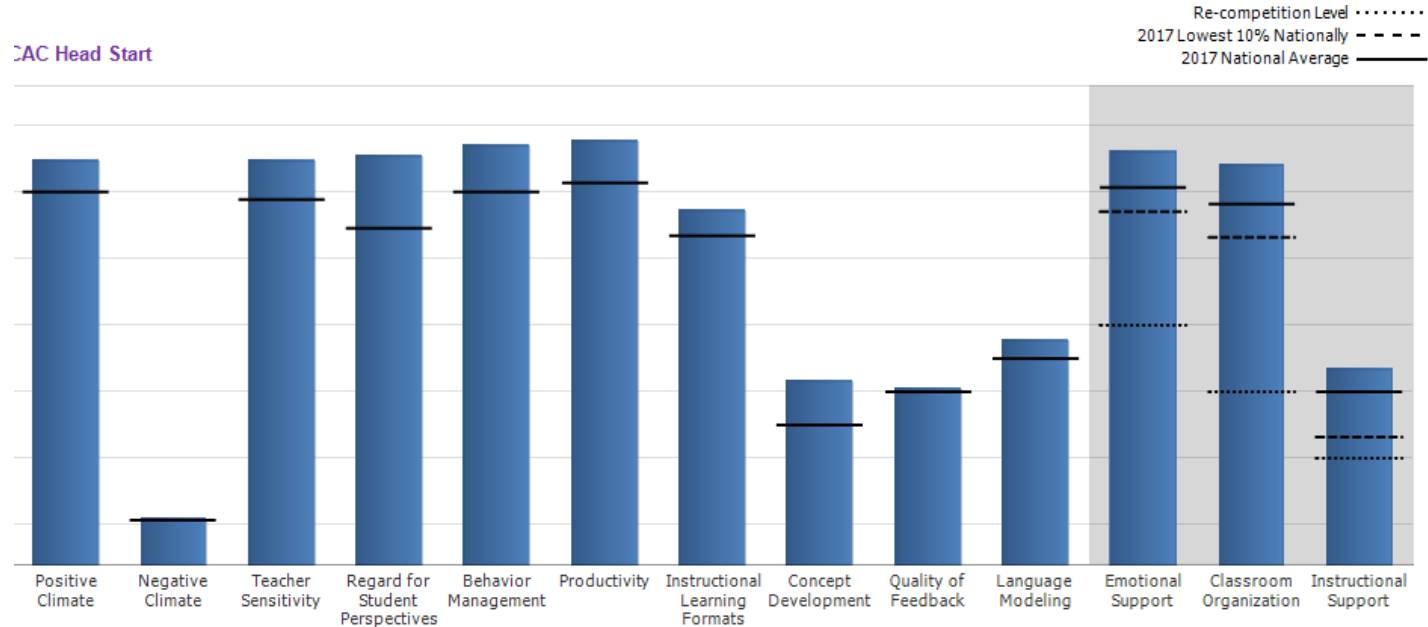


Across program types: Below WHE

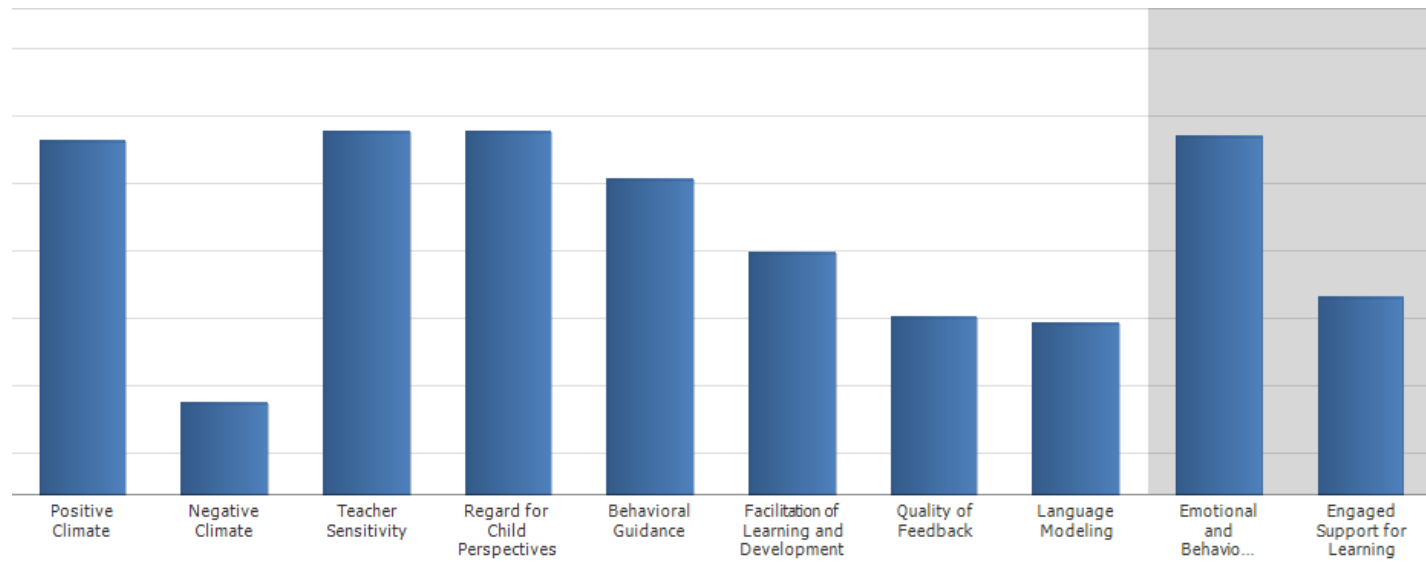
