

Eligibility

Applicants must first apply for Energy Assistance (EA) before being considered for the Energy Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP). Payments are based on household size and income.

Crisis includes a sudden, unexpected, uncontrollable loss of financial resources, life-threatening conditions (utility services disconnected or fuel depleted), and circumstances that threaten the stability if energy aid is not supplied.

Energy Assistance

EA provides a one-time payment for help with winter heating costs for low-income households. The program operates October - September.

Energy Crisis Intervention Program

ECIP provides heating and cooling utility relief and assistance. The winter heating program operates October - September; the summer cooling program operates June - September.

Low Income Home Water Assistance Program

LIHWAP may assist with a one-time payment for water and/or wastewater (sewer) bill. The program operates November – September.
